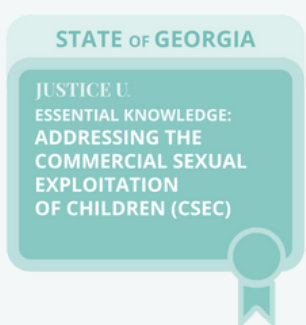
COMPLETE: CSEC Awareness for Georgia (live event or online course)
